Dear ██████████,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 22 January 2026. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion by the Commander, Navy Personnel Command memorandum ██████████, which was previously provided to you for comment.

The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. Therefore, the Board determined that a personal appearance was not necessary and considered your case based on the evidence of record.

Your Record of Military Processing – Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 1966) signed on 10 May 2019, block 4 (home of record (HOR) Address)) listed ██████████  
██████████ 93551, block 14 (Valid Driver's License) listed ██████████, block 15 (Place of Birth) ██████████  
██████████, and block 22 (Education) listed schools ██████████  
██████████ for the period of August 2013 to June 2017, and University of ██████████  
██████████ for the period of August 2017 to Present.

Your Enlistment/Reenlistment Document Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 4) signed on 10 May 2019, block 3 (HOR) listed ██████████.

You were released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve with an honorable character of service and were issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 6 January 2020 to 21 May 2020 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, block 8a (Place of Entry into Active Duty) listed ██████████, and block 8b (HOR at time of entry) listed ██████████.

On 16 February 2021, you were issued BUPERS Activation/Order to active duty Order: ██████████ (Official recall to active duty mobilization Orders) from ██████████ with a report estimated date of arrival of 28 March 2025. Your ultimate activity was ██████████ ██████████ for active duty with an effective date of arrival of 21 April 2025 with an estimated ultimate activity detach date of 5 November 2025. Furthermore, the following was listed: Unclassified Location: ██████████. Per MILPERSMAN 1000-100, prior to execution of these orders, the member and the Navy Reserve Activity (NRA) are directed to verify that the member's address listed above corresponds with the member's current residence on file and in Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS). All address changes in NSIPS will require an order modification; failure to do so may result in erroneous pay and entitlements while the member is activated. PERS-461 requires receipt of address change requests no later than five business days prior to Ready Load Date (RLD).

On 28 February 2025, you signed a Lease Agreement with ██████████ for rental unit ██████████ for the period of 28 February 2025 through 27 April 2026.

On 17 March 2025, you signed a Report of HOR and Place from which orders to active Duty (NAVPERS 1070/74) section III (My HOR and the Place from Which I was Ordered into the Tour of Active Duty for Which I am Reporting are:) block 1 (HOR) listed ██████████ ██████████, and block 2 (Place from which ordered to active duty) listed ██████████. Furthermore, certifying officer signed on 11 March 2025.

On 28 March 2025, you reported to NOSC ██████████.

On 17 April 2025, Commanding Officer, Navy Reserve Center ██████████ notified Commander, Navy Personnel Command (PERS 461) that "██████████ is in receipt of Mobilization Orders Date Time Group (DTG) ██████████. He resides in ██████████ not ██████████ as indicated on his orders. Per MILPERSMAN 1000-100, NAVPERS 1070/74 is submitted to correct the Place From Which Ordered to Active Duty on ██████████ mobilization order and Lease or mortgage agreement verifies the address change. It is requested that the address on the order be changed to the following..., ██████████.

Per BUPERSINST1001.39F, the member is required to keep the Navy Reserve Center Commanding Officer informed of their current address. The following is the reason the change did not take effect by the DTG on the member's orders and justification for authorizing this change: The member was in-between moving homes and did not have the address change prior to the DTG. The new address took effect on 28 FEB 2025."
