This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 28 May 2025. The Board determined your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. In your application, you requested your “continued medical issue to be diagnosed correctly as [Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease].” You contend the correction should be made because “even during the original diagnosis, it was written as ‘PROBABLE exercise induced asthma’ which has now been determined to have been misdiagnose[d].” The Board, noting you were discharged in July 2006, observed you did not provide a basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. Thus, the Board determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
