1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract executed on 10 October 2024 was expunged, and he signed an agreement to extend enlistment to meet service obligation.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████ and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 December 2025 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 10 June 2019, Petitioner entered active duty

b. On 14 October 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an expiration of active obligated service (EAOS) of 13 October 2026 and received a zone A Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

c. On 6 November 2022, Petitioner transferred from ██████████ and reported to ██████████ on 6 November 2022 for temporary duty.

d. In February 2023, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) P05A. In March 2023, Petitioner was awarded NEC P13A.

e. On 30 March 2023, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and reported to [REDACTED] on 1 April 2023 for duty.

f. On 3 June 2024, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 1554) with required obligated service to November 2027, while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of October 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 November 2024, with a projected rotation date of November 2027.

g. On 10 October 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 9 October 2030.

h. On 9 October 2024, [REDACTED] issued Petitioner an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) listing the following: "Entitled to SRB based on the MA Rating/NEC 0000, SRB zone A, Award Level 2.0. The total SRB entitlement is \$26,364.65. First installment of \$13,182.32 will be deposited to your DDS account by EFT payment when the entitlement has posted to the Member Pay Account."

i. On 13 October 2024, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and reported to [REDACTED] on 5 November 2024 for duty.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 14 October 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and received a zone A SRB. On 3 June 2024, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 1554 with required obligated service to November 2027. On 10 October 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years. At that time, Petitioner was erroneously approved for a zone A SRB. In accordance with reference (b),<sup>1</sup> a member may receive only one SRB per zone in a career. The Board determined that Petitioner should have been advised to sign an extension of enlistment to meet the obligated service vice reenlist.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 10 October 2024 for a term of 6 years is null and void.

Petitioner executed an agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) for 13 months operative on 14 October 2026.

<sup>1</sup> A member may receive only one SRB per zone during a career. When reenlisting for SRB, the reenlistment must take the member's new EAOS into the next SRB zone.
