1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to the Loan Repayment Program.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████ and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 December 2025 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 17 January 2025, Petitioner enlisted in the Navy for a term of 8 years of which 4 years is considered an active duty obligation. NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees – Annex "A" listed Assignment to Musician "A" School, Navy School of Music, Norfolk, VA; and Enlistment Bonus for Shipping (EBSHP) - \$5,000 Bonus. Active Duty Service Date: 3 February 2025.

b. On 27 January 2025, Navy Recruiting Official signed 21 DD Form 2475, DOD Educational Loan Repayment (LRP) Annual Applications totaling \$49,414. On 27 January 2025, Petitioner signed the forms authorizing the release of his financial data by the lender.

c. On 3 February 2025, Petitioner entered active duty.

d. On 12 February 2025, US Department of Education Certifying Officer verified and signed the aforementioned LRP applications.

e. On [REDACTED], Petitioner completed Recruit Basic Military Training.

f. On 11 April 2025, the Master Military Pay Accounting reflects \$5,000 enlistment bonus was processed for payment.

g. On [REDACTED], Petitioner reported to his first permanent duty station at Navy Band, [REDACTED] for duty.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner met the eligibility criteria for LRP in accordance with reference (b).<sup>1</sup> However, because LRP was not annotated on the Petitioner's Annex "A," he was deemed ineligible to receive the incentive. Although proper administrative requirements were not completed, the Board determined that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantee – Annex "A" to DD Form 4 dated 17 January 2025 is amended to reflect Option 3: "Loan Repayment Program – Up to \$65,000" vice "N/A."

Petitioner completed and submitted all required Loan Repayment Program documents to cognizant authorities in a timely manner. Note: To complete the process, Petitioner must contact the Navy Recruiting Command (NRC) LRP Program Manager at [cnrc\\_lrp-eb@navy.mil](mailto:cnrc_lrp-eb@navy.mil) with contact information to include address, email, and phone numbers. Additionally, Petitioner must provide the NRC LRP Program Manager with lender signed copies of updated DD Form 2475 and a copy of this letter.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

<sup>1</sup> Any future Sailor initially classified or reclassified on or after 6 January 2025 in any rating/programs that shipped October through September of any fiscal year were eligible for LRP up to \$65,000. Future Sailors must access to Active Component and have LRP listed as a guarantee in their current Annex to DD Form 4, Enlistment/Reenlistment Document in order to maintain eligibility. Applicant must have a 50 Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) score.
