Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552, in which you requested to remove your 27 November 2003 nonjudicial punishment (NJP). You also requested the Navy Good Conduct and Korean Defense Service Medal.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 28 May 2025. In reviewing your application, the Board observed that you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your NJP.

Concerning your request for the Korean Defense Service Medal, you have not exhausted your administrative remedies and must submit your request to the Chief of Naval Operations.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
