paygrade, a PMA of 3.60 will be assigned to their worksheet/answer sheet. This PMA will be used solely for the current NWAEE and will not be utilized in future PMA computations.

b. Reference (c) specified the deadline for advancement candidates to complete Professional Military Knowledge-Eligibility Exam (PMK-EE) was 31 July 2023; minimum time-in-rate (TIR) for E-5 candidates was 1 January 2023; and candidates taking the E-5 NWAEE had their PMA computed using all evaluations in the current pay grade that fell within the 1 June 2022 to 31 August 2023 period.

c. On 13 September 2021, Petitioner entered active duty in paygrade E-2, completed Recruit Basic Military Training on 3 December 2021 and reported to [REDACTED] as a student on temporary duty.

d. On 24 February 2022, Petitioner detached [REDACTED] and report to [REDACTED] as a student for duty under instruction.

e. On 16 June 2022, Petitioner advanced to Information Systems Technician-Submarine Seaman (ITSSN)/E-3.

f. On 5 December 2022, Petitioner completed IS Technician Submarines Blk 0 course and advanced to ITS3/E-4 effective 16 December 2022.

g. Petitioner issued Detachment evaluation in the rate of ITSSN for period of report from 24 February 2022 to 30 March 2023 and received a Promotable promotion recommendation. On 30 March 2023, Petitioner detached [REDACTED].

h. Petitioner reported to [REDACTED] for temporary duty from 21 April 2023 to 5 July 2023. Thereafter, Petitioner reported to his first permanent duty station, [REDACTED] for duty.

i. On 20 July 2023, Petitioner completed PMK-EE for E-5.

j. In March 2024, Petitioner participated in Cycle 263 and was selected for advancement to ITE2/E-5.

k. Petitioner issued Promotion/Frocking evaluation in the rate of ITE3 for period of report from 21 April 2023 to 1 June 2024 and received an Must Promote promotion recommendation.

l. On 16 December 2024, Petitioner advanced to ITE2/E-5.

m. On 3 June 2025, Naval Education Training and Professional Development Center (NETPDC) completed a standard score comparison of Petitioner's March 2024 (Cycle 263) NWAEE to the September 2023 (Cycle 260) NWAEE using a 3.60 PMA. NETPDC determined his final multiple score (FMS) of 97.42 exceeded the minimum multiple required (MMR) of 20.00 for advancement to ITE2/E-5 effective 16 June 2024 with a TIR date of 1 January 2024.

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CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner met the basic criteria to participate in the September 2023 (Cycle 260) NWAE. However, the Board determined that an administrative error with Petitioner's evaluation ending 30 March 2023, incorrectly listed his rate as ITSSN vice ITS3, rendering him ineligible to participate in the Cycle 260 NWAE in accordance with references (b) and (c). Therefore, the Board determined that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's Detachment evaluation for period of report from 24 February 2022 to 30 March 2023 is amended to reflect Block 2. Rate "ITS3" vice "ITSSN."

After comparison of March 2024 (Cycle 263) NWAE to the September 2023 (Cycle 260) NWAE, Petitioner received the following scores: Standard Score 9/65.12; PMA 3.60/32.00; Service in Pay Grade (SIPG) (0106)/00.30; Awards 00.00, Education 0.00; passe not advanced (PNA) N/A/00.00; and FMS/MMR = 97.42/20.00. Final Status: Selected.

Petitioner advanced to ITE2/E-5 effective "16 June 2024" vice "16 December 2024" with a TIR date of "1 January 2024" vice "1 July 2024."

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
