1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish eligibility for the Loan Repayment Program (LRP).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 February 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. In accordance with reference (b), the LRP application is complete when the applicant selects the LRP option during the classification process and provides all items listed on the LRP Worksheet to the Navy Recruiting Command (NAVCRUITCOM) LRP Manager, and receives final approval for enrollment into LRP via Personalized Recruiting for Immediate and Delayed Enlistment Modernization (PRIDE Mod) II. Initial request for LRP in PRIDE Mod II must be submitted at least 70 days prior to shipping. Exceptions to policy may be requested. LRP applicants who do not have an NAVCRUITCOM approved LRP application within 10 days of shipping to Recruiting Training Command must be rolled out to a later date, or sign a decline letter and be provided a new enlistment guarantee.

b. Reference (c) indicated any future Sailors (FS) initially classified or reclassified (change in program, rate, or ship date) on or after 20 August 2023. For reclassifications that occur while in delayed entry program the classifier must apply the enlistment bonus that is in effect the day of reclassification. Active Component (AC) recruits in any rating/program that shipped in August 2024 through December 2024 were eligible for \$10,000 Enlistment Bonus for Shipping (EBSHP). Additionally, AC recruits in any rating/program that completed 96 or greater semester hours were eligible for a \$7,000 Enlistment Bonus for College Credit (EBCC). EBSHP and EBCC are earned and payable upon graduation of Recruit Training Command (RTC). FS in any rating/program that shipped October through September of any fiscal year were eligible for LRP up to \$ 65,000. The Sailor must access to AC and have LRP listed as a guarantee on their current NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees in order to maintain eligibility. Applicant must have a 50 Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) score.

c. On 20 September 2023, [REDACTED] generated a transcript that reflects Petitioner was enrolled in the Bachelor of Music program with a major in Music Education Jazz and completed 110 semester hours.

d. On 4 October 2023, Petitioner enlisted in the Navy for 8-years of which 4-years was considered an active duty obligation. NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees – Annex “A” listed Assignment to [REDACTED] and Enlistment Bonus for College Credit (EBCC) - \$8,000 Bonus. Active Duty Service Date (ADSD): 6 February 2024.

e. On 27 October 2023, PRIDE MOD II reflects Petitioner’s ADSD changed to 13 November 2023.

f. On 13 November 2023, Petitioner entered active duty in paygrade E-3.

g. On 26 January 2024, Petitioner completed Recruit Basic Military Training and the Master Military Pay Account (MMPA) reflects an \$8,000 enlistment bonus was processed for payment.

h. On 20 February 2024, Navy Recruiting Command LRP Manager issued Petitioner Future Sailor Final Approval Loan Repayment Program notification. The approval was for \$57,100 based on completed DD Form 2475, DOD Educational Loan Repayment Program (LRP) Annual Applications.

i. On 10 October 2024, Petitioner’s record was corrected to issue NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees – Annex “B” and establish entitlement to \$10,000 EBSHP and \$7,000 EBCC (Docket No. 2977-2).

j. On 19 February 2025, Petitioner’s MMPA record reflects a \$9,000 enlistment bonus was processed for payment.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner enlisted on 4 October 2023 and met the eligibility criteria for LRP, EBCC and EBSHP in accordance with reference (c). However, because LRP was not annotated on the Petitioner's Annex B, he was deemed ineligible to receive the incentive. Although the proper administrative requirements were not completed, the Board determined that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's NAVCRUIT 1133/52 Enlistment Guarantee - Annex "B" to DD Form 4 dated 4 October 2023 is amended to reflect Option 4: Loan Repayment Program - Up to \$ 65,000.

Petitioner completed and submitted all required Loan Repayment Program documents to cognizant authorities in a timely manner.

Additionally, Petitioner must provide the NRC LRP Program Manager with lender signed copies of updated DD Form 2475 and a copy of this letter.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
