Dear ████████████████████,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 12 February 2026. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in in Headquarters, U. S . Marine Corps memorandum 5420 MMEA of 28 May 2025. The advisory opinion was provided to you on 5 June 2025, and you were given 30 days in which to submit a response. Although you were afforded an opportunity to submit a rebuttal, you did not do so.

The Board has reviewed your request for the FY13 Zone A Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) of \$24,750 for Primary Military Occupational Specialty 0861. In its review, the Board considered your assertions and all mitigating factors. The Board concluded that your request must be denied. The decision is based on the following: 1) on 10 June 2013, you were approved for a Quality Reenlistment Program (QRP) reenlistment, which is not authorized an SRB per MARADMIN 357/12; 2) you accepted this QRP authority on 17 June 2013, and subsequently reenlisted for 48 months on 18 June 2013, and 3) MARADMIN 301/12 explicitly states that QRP reenlistments are not authorized a bonus. Based on these facts, the Board found no probable material error, substantive inaccuracy, or injustice warranting corrective action.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
