Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 18 December 2025. In your application, you requested “removal of TDRL from DD-214” because being taken off the Temporary Disability Retired List (TDRL) “was affecting [your] service computation date.” In reviewing your application, the Board noted you were notified by Commander, Navy Personnel Command (PERS 95) on 3 October 2019 that you had been removed from the TDRL effective 26 May 2005 after the determination you were “fit to return from Temporary Retirement”. The Board observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse the failure to submit the application in a timely manner, using either the date of your removal from the TDRL or the 2019 date of the PERS-95 notification, and was not willing to waive the three-year statute of limitations due to the length of time.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
