1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's reenlistment on 6 March 2025 was for a term of 5 years vice 4 years and that she was eligible for and received the approved Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 26 February 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

- a. On 11 July 2012, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. In June 2017, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) A16A, 8CFL, and 791F.
- c. On 17 March 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 16 March 2026.

- d. On 11 July 2022, Petitioner entered Zone C.
- e. In December 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC 8CFL.
- f. On 18 December 2023, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]), with required obligated service to July 2027, while stationed in NAVSPECWAR [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of May 2024. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 18 May 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 20 July 2024 with a Projected Rotation Date of July 2027.
- g. On 5 February 2024, the Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Seric Record (ESR) shows Petitioner extended for 16 months with a Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 16 July 2027.
- h. On 17 May 2024, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived at [REDACTED] on 19 May 2024 for temporary duty.
- i. In June 2024, Petitioner was awarded NEC 804G.
- j. On 15 June 2024, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived at [REDACTED] on 9 July 2024 for duty.
- k. On 3 February 2025, Petitioner signed a Command Career Request (NPPSC 1160/1) for a 4 year reenlistment with an effective date of 15 April 2025. Furthermore, Petitioner's request was approved by cognizant authority on 19 February 2025.
- l. On 15 April 2025, [REDACTED] issued Petitioner an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) listing the following: Entitled to SRB based on the YN rating, NEC 0000, Zone C, award level 0.5. Total entitlement; \$5,336.03. First installment: \$2,918.02. Anniversary Installment: \$972.67. Member has acknowledged that entitlement to SRB must continue in order to receive subsequent installments.
- m. On 15 April 2025, EODMU 2 issued Petitioner an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) listing the following: Entitled to SRB based on the YN rating, NEC 0000, Zone C, award level 0.5. Total entitlement: \$2,244.63. First installment: \$1,122.32. Anniversary Installment: \$347.10. Member has acknowledged that entitlement to SRB must continue in order to receive subsequent installments.
- n. On 15 April 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 14 April 2029 and received a Zone C SRB.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 16 October 2024, reference (d)¹ was published authorizing a Zone C SRB for the YN rate. On 15 April 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and was approved to receive a Zone C SRB. However, Petitioner's 16 month inoperative extension counted against the SRB. The Board determined that Petitioner should have been advised to reenlist for 5 years vice 4 years to account for her inoperative extension and receive the higher SRB amount.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 15 April 2025 was for a term of 5 years vice 4 years.

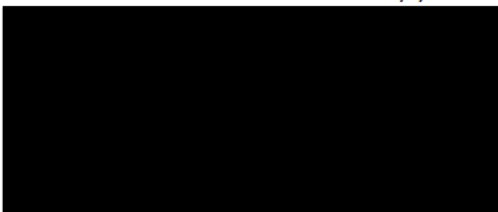
Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone C SRB with an award level of 0.5 (\$30,000 dollar award ceiling) for the YN rate. Remaining obligated service to 16 March 2026 will be deducted from SRB computation. The Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine amounts due, if any.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
