1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's reenlistment on 1 February 2025 was for a term of 3 years vice 2 years.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 26 February 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 5 April 2012, Petitioner enlisted in the U.S. Naval Reserve for 8 years with an Expiration of Obligated Service of 4 April 2020.

b. Petitioner was released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve with an honorable character of service and was issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 24 July 2012 to 21 March 2020 upon completion of required active service.

c. On 22 March 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 2 years with a new contract expiration date of 21 March 2022.

d. On 8 February 2022, Petitioner signed an Agreement to Extend Enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) for 12 months with a new contract expiration date of 21 March 2023.

e. On 25 February 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 2 years with a new contract expiration date of 24 February 2025.

f. Petitioner completed a Drilling Reserve Worksheet (reenlistment/extension) requesting a 3 year reenlistment effective 1 February 2025. Furthermore, Petitioner's request was approved by cognizant authority on 12 January 2025.

g. On 1 February 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 2 years with a new contract expiration date of 31 January 2027.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner requested a 3 year reenlistment effective 1 February 2025, however due to administrative error, the reenlistment contract reflects only a 2 year term. Therefore, the Board determined under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 1 February 2025 was for a term of 3 years vice 2 years.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
