Dear ██████████,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 17 March 2026. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in Commander, Navy Personnel Command (NPC) memorandum ██████████. The advisory opinion was provided to you on 22 December 2025, and you were given 30 days in which to submit a response. Although you were afforded an opportunity to submit a rebuttal, you did not do so.

You requested to correct block 12.b (Separation Date This Period) on your Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) ending on 23 June 2023. The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board agreed that your Official Separation Orders erroneously list two separation dates. However, the 23 June 2023 separation date is correct in accordance with NPC message issued 18 May 2023, which details a disability rating of 20 percent and a separation date of 23 June 2023. You assert that, "[m]y discharge date is incorrect as I was still fulfilling active duties the discharge date on the DD214 is 06/2023 and actual discharge is 02/2024." However, Navy Reserve Center (NRC) ██████████ does not confirm that you physically reported to the NRC from June 2023 to February 2024, therefore the Board determined that a change to your record is not warranted. In this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the aforementioned advisory opinion.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
