1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract executed on 15 September 2023 was expunged, and the End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) be reset to reflect 14 September 2026.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 27 January 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 15 September 2020, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an EAOS of 14 September 2024 and Soft EAOS of 14 September 2026.

b. In November 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N91T.

c. On 14 June 2022, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: ██████████) while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of August 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was ██████████ for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 September 2022 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of March 2027.

d. In August 2022 Petitioner was awarded NEC N25O.

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e. On 12 August 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and reported to [REDACTED] on 6 September 2022 for duty.

f. On 27 June 2023, Petitioner's Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) precertification was approved, listing a 48 month reenlistment effective 15 September 2023 and a zone A SRB total amount of \$15,276.

g. On 15 September 2023, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/ Electronic Service Record (ESR) reflects that Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 14 September 2027. Furthermore, Petitioner provided an unsigned Immediate Reenlistment Contract (NAVPERS 1070/601), Official NSIPS/ESR form printed on 31 August 2023.

h. In September 2024 Petitioner was awarded NEC N25S.

i. CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 14 June 2022, Petitioner was issued orders [REDACTED]. No obligated service was required, however the PRD was 6 months beyond his Soft EAOS. NSIPS/ESR reflects a 4-year reenlistment effective 15 September 2023, that he claims he did not sign. On 20 February 2024, an SRB was processed for payment, but subsequently recouped. The Board determined there is insufficient evidence of Petitioner having signed a NAVPERS 1070/601, therefore under these circumstances relief is warranted. Petitioner is subject to recoupment of SRB, the amount will be determined by the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS).

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RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 15 September 2023 for a term of 4 years is null and void.

Note: This change will reestablish Petitioner's previous EAOS of 14 September 2026. Furthermore, DFAS will complete an audit of Petitioner's financial record to determine if recoupment is complete.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
