	Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of nd injustice, finds as follows:
	Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
	Although enclosure (1) was not filed in a timely manner, the Board found it in the interest ice to waive the statute of limitations and consider the case on its merits.
Althou certific	Petitioner enlisted in the Navy and began a period of active service on 13 July 1950. In the sate indicates his legal middle name as " Other documents present in his Official by Personnel File, including his Record of Emergency Data, confirm his middle name as ."
d.	Petitioner received an Honorable discharge upon completion of his enlistment on 14

January 1954. His DD Form 214 erroneously reflects his middle name as "..."

As discussed above, the Board determined Petitioner's correct, legal, middle name, was "Petitioner's DD Form 214 erroneously annotates his middle name and requires correction.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action:

That Petitioner be issued a "Correction to DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty" (DD Form 215) indicating his middle name of "..."

That a copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
