1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to show that Petitioner was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Retention Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 February 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

- a. On 13 October 2015, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. On 28 April 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an Expiration of Current Contract (ECC) of 27 April 2024.
- c. On 16 December 2020, Petitioner was assigned ADMOS1 8411.
- d. On 26 May 2022, Petitioner executed an agreement to extend enlistment for 2 months with an End of Active Service of 27 June 2024 in order to obligate service for promotion.
- e. On 2 June 2022, Petitioner was promoted to Staff Sergeant/E-6.

f. On 21 December 2023, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted requesting a 48 month reenlistment in Primary Military Occupational Specialty (PMOS). Petitioner's Billet Desc: Production Recruiter. Petitioner's request was approved by Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps (HQMC) on 28 December 2023. Approved MOS: 5711.

g. On 6 January 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an ECC of 5 January 2028.

h. On 17 January 2024, Petitioner transferred from Monitored Command Codes (MCC) [REDACTED] and joined to MCC [REDACTED] on 15 February 2024 for duty.

i. On 26 November 2024, Petitioner was assigned PMOS 5769.

j. On 26 November 2024, United States Marine Corps, Marine Corps Detachment [REDACTED] certified that Petitioner met all the requirements and has successfully completed the curriculum prescribed for the Chemical Biological Radiological Nuclear Chief Course.

k. On 1 January 2026, Petitioner was promoted to Gunnery Sergeant/E-7.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that in accordance with reference (b), Career Progression (CP) PMOS are authorized bonus payments to Marines who hold a feeder PMOS, possess the intended MOS and are registered for the PMOS producing course. Marines currently serving on an Special Duty Assignment (SDA) or slated to attend an SDA are exempt from the class registration requirement due to the inability to register or attend the PMOS producing course. On 21 December 2023, Petitioner's command submitted a FY24 48-month reenlistment in PMOS 5711 to HQMC. On 28 December 2023, Petitioner was approved for a 48-month reenlistment by HQMC without the Career Progression SRB. On 6 January 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years. At the time of reenlistment, Petitioner was assigned to recruiting duty. Petitioner earned PMOS 5769 on 26 November 2024. In accordance with reference (b), Marines who are in training beyond 30 September 2024 will be authorized payment of the PMOS bonus once the Marine Corps Total Force System shows they have been awarded the new PMOS. The Board determined that Petitioner was eligible for an SRB in conjunction with her reenlistment, however due to administrative oversight, one was not requested. Therefore, the Board determined that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner enlistment/reenlistment document (DD Form 4) executed on 6 January 2024 is for a term of 4 years and 4 months vice 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone B SRB for MOS 5769CP, E-6 and above, which is capped at \$8,600 for 48 months of additional obligated service. Remaining obligated service to 27 April 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
