1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 1 May 2024 vice 30 October 2024 for a term of 6 years and that he was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 5 March 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

- a. On 10 August 2010, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. In October 2014, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) 746A.
- c. On 28 September 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 27 September 2023.
- d. In April 2018, Petitioner was awarded NEC H04A and 723B.
- e. On 10 August 2020, Petitioner entered Zone C.

f. On 1 May 2021, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 10-month agreement to extend enlistment with a Soft EAOS of 27 July 2024.

g. In September 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC H09A and H00M. In October 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A. In April 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC 741A.

h. On 21 March 2023, NSIPS/ESR shows a 4-month agreement to extend enlistment with a Soft EAOS of 27 November 2024.

i. On 28 September 2023, NSIPS/ESR shows a 14-month agreement to extend enlistment with a Soft EAOS of 27 January 2026.

j. In May 2024, Petitioner was awarded NEC 8MTS.

k. On 10 August 2024, Petitioner entered Zone D.

l. On 27 September 2024, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2714), with required obligated service to April 2028, while stationed at [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of January 2025. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 11 January 2025. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 5 April 2025 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of April 2028.

m. On 30 October 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 29 October 2030.

n. On 10 January 2025, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 10 January 2025 for temporary duty.

o. In March 2025, Petitioner was awarded NEC 742A.

p. On 4 March 2025, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 3 April 2025 for temporary duty.

q. On 8 April 2025, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2714), while stationed at [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of January 2025. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 19 January 2025. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 5 April 2025 with a PRD of April 2028.

r. On 1 May 2025, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 3 May 2025 for temporary duty.

s. On 12 May 2025, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 19 May 2025 for duty.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 15 April 2024, reference (c) was published, authorizing a Zone C SRB. At that time, Petitioner was within 365 days of his EAOS and in accordance with reference (b), was eligible to reenlist for SRB. If the Command Career Counselor properly counseled Petitioner, he could have reenlisted prior to entering Zone D. On 1 May 2024, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 6 years and receive a Zone C SRB. Therefore, under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 30 April 2024/1 May 2024 vice 29/30 October 2024 for a term of 6 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone C SRB with an award level of 1.5 (\$45,000 award ceiling) for the IT. Remaining obligated service to 27 July 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
