1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Retention Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 March 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 8 January 2019, Petitioner entered active duty.

b. On 20 November 2019, Petitioner was assigned Primary Military Occupational Specialties (PMOS) 0631.

c. On 16 December 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years and 1 month with an End of Current Contract (ECC) of 15 January 2026 and received a Zone A SRB.

d. On 1 June 2024, Petitioner was promoted to Sergeant/E-5.

e. On 8 January 2025, Petitioner entered Zone B.

f. On 7 March 2025, Petitioner signed a Reenlistment Extension Lateral Move (RELM) Request (NAVMC 11537) for a term of 48 months. Furthermore, Petitioner's request was approved by cognizant authority on 17 March 2025.

g. On 19 March 2025, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty SDA w/ Reenlistment/ HSST request was submitted.

h. On 12 May 2025, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty SDA w/ Reenlistment/ HSST request was approved by Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps (HQMC). Approved MOS: 0631.

i. On 4 June 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and 8 months with an ECC of 3 February 2030.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 19 March 2025, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted to HQMC. At the time of submission, Petitioner was eligible for a Zone B SRB in accordance with references (b) and (c). On 14 April 2025, reference (d) was published and did not authorize a Zone B SRB for 0621, E5. In accordance with enclosure (2), Petitioner's request was not approved until 12 May 2025 due to *lack of SRB funding*. On 4 June 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and 8 months with no SRB. The Board determined availability of funding would have prevented this issue, therefore under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 10/11 April 2025 vice 3/4 June 2025 for a term of 4 years and 10 months vice 4 years and 8 months.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone B SRB for PMOS 0631, E5, which is capped at \$18,630. Remaining obligated service to 15 January 2026 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and

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having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
