1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's reenlistment of 27 March 2023 reflected USNR vice USN.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 March 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. Petitioner's Record of Military Processing – Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 1966) signed on 17 March 2019 listed the following: Block 32 (Specific Option/Program Enlisted for, Military Skill, or Assignment to a Geographical Area Guarantees) "Full Time Support Logistics Specialist (LS)."

b. Petitioner's Enlistment/Reenlistment Document Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 4) executed on 11 April 2019 listed the following: Block B8 (Agreements) "I am enlisting/reenlisting in the United States (list branch of service) NAVAL RESERVE this date for 8 years and 0 weeks beginning in pay grade E-1 of which 0 years and 0 weeks is considered an Active Duty Obligation, and 8 years and 0 weeks will be served in the Reserve Component of the Service in which I have enlisted." Furthermore, block F20a (Discharge From/Delayed Entry/Enlistment Program) "I request to be discharged from the Delayed Entry/Enlistment Program (DEP) and enlisted in the Regular Component of the United States (list branch of service) NAVY for a period of 4 years and 0 weeks."

c. Petitioner's Enlistment Guarantees (NAVCRUIT 1133/52) Annex A to DD Form 4 dated 11 April 2019 signed on 11 April 2019 listed the following: "ACKNOWLEDGEMENT : In connection with my enlistment into the United States Navy (Active) Component, I acknowledge that I am

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enlisting for a total Military Service Obligation (MSO) of 8 years. I fully understand and acknowledge that my MSO consists of an active duty obligation of 4 years as indicated in the options listed below with the remaining months 48 of my MSO served in the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR). I understand my contract has the following guaranteed options which require the indicated active duty service obligation(s): Option 1 FULL TIME SUPPORT LOGISTICS SPECIALIST (LS); requires 4 years active duty obligation and a voluntary extension of N/A months to meet the rating, school, and program guarantee active duty obligation requirement.”

d. On 28 March 2023, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System/Electronic Service Record shows Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS)/Soft EAOS of 27 March 2027.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that due to administrative error, Petitioner’s reenlistment contract was marked BR/CL USN rather than USNR, therefore relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner’s naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner’s immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 28 March 2023 listed the following: BR/CL USNR vice USN, RADO Months/Days: 048/000 vice 000/000.

Furthermore, any other entries affected by the Board’s recommendation be corrected.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner’s naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board’s review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board’s proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
