1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to list her cumulative Sea Service of 4 years 1 month 25 days in block 12g on her Certificate of Release or Discharge From Active Duty (DD Form 214) issued in 2017, and to show that Petitioner was paid the correct Sea Pay while assigned to ██████████

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 February 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 14 May 2013, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3402), while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of February 2013. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was ██████████ for temporary duty under instructions with an effective date of arrival of 18 February 2013. Petitioner's intermediate (02) activity was ██████████ for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 9 May 2013. Petitioner's ultimate activity was ██████████ for duty with an effective date of arrival of 3 June 2013 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of June 2018.

b. On 22 May 2013, Petitioner transferred from ██████████ and arrived to ██████████ on 6 June 2013 for duty.

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c. On 16 November 2016, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3216) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of November 2016. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty – limited duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 November 2016 with a PRD of June 2017.

d. On 30 November 2016, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 30 November 2016 for duty.

e. JUMPS LES ONLINE INQUIRY SYSTEM LES-ARCHIVE LOCAL-PRINT for period covered 1-30 November 2016 listed a Sea Duty Time of 3 years, 5 months, and 25 days.

f. Petitioner was released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve with an honorable character of service and was issued a DD Form 214 for the period of 7 November 2012 to 6 July 2017 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, block 12c (Net Active Services This Period) listed 4 years, 8 months, and 0 days, and block 12g (Sea Service) listed 0 years, 0 months, and 0 days.

g. JUMPS LES ONLINE INQUIRY SYSTEM LES-ARCHIVE LOCAL-PRINT for period covered 1-31 July 2017 listed a Sea Duty Time of 4 years, 1 month, and 25 days.

h. Petitioner was released from active duty for ADT with an honorable character of service and was issued a DD Form 214 for the period of 24 January 2022 to 23 May 2022 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, block 12c (Net Active Services This Period) listed 0 years, 4 months, and 9 days, and block 12g (Sea Service) listed 0 years, 0 months, and 0 days.

i. On 17 February 2023, Petitioner reenlisted in the U.S. Navy for 6 years with an End of Active Obligated Service of 16 February 2029.

j. On 14 July 2023, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 28 July 2023 for duty.

k. Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account listed the following (Sea Duty Counter): ENTRY-OPEN-DT 250728 01 08 1 DAYS-CUM 00933.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of reference (d), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that on 6 June 2013, Petitioner reported to [REDACTED] for duty. On 30 November 2016, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED]. Therefore, Petitioner accumulated 3 years 5 months 25 days of sea service, however her DD Form 214 for the period of 7 November 2012 to 6 July 2017 does not list any sea service in accordance with reference (d). Additionally, the Board noted that in accordance with reference (b), Petitioner would have been eligible for Career Sea Pay (CSP) Premium (CSPP) during her tour on the 1st day of the 37th consecutive month of creditable sea duty. Additionally, due to the erroneous sea service,

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Petitioner would have received incorrect CSP payments during her assignment to [REDACTED] effective 28 July 2023. However, the Board agreed the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) will audit Petitioner's CSP account for the appropriate CSP/CSPP for all periods of eligibility. That part of the Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing be denied. Petitioner requested cumulative sea duty period of 4 years 1 month 25 days, however sea time is computed from the report date to the detach date from ACU 2 and the Board could not determine if her follow on assignment was a sea duty assignment.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214 with a separation date this period of 6 July 2017 listed the following: block 12g (Sea Service) 3 years, 5 months, and 25 days vice 0 years, 0 months, and 0 days.

Note: The DFAS will complete an audit of Petitioner's financial record specifically Career Sea Pay and Career Sea Pay Premium after her transfer on 30 November 2016 from [REDACTED] to present, to determine amounts due, if any.

That no further changes be made to Petitioner's naval record.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
