1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Retention Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 2 April 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

- a. On 17 April 2017, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. On 13 December 2017, Petitioner was assigned Primary Military Occupational Specialties (PMOS) 1371.
- c. On 6 January 2021, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an End of Current Contract (ECC) of 5 January 2025.

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d. On 23 November 2021, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 2 months with an end of active service of 5 March 2025 to gain obligated service to attend [REDACTED].

e. On 2 March 2022, Petitioner was assigned ADMOS1 8411.

f. On 17 April 2023, Petitioner entered Zone B.

g. On 28 December 2023, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 10 months with an EAS of 5 January 2026 to gain obligated service for promotion.

h. On 2 January 2024, Petitioner was promoted to Staff Sergeant/E6.

i. On 12 February 2025, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted to Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps (HQMC) requesting a 48 month reenlistment and Zone B SRBP under FY25 SRBP. Audit History shows: Forwarded on 24 February 2025...awaiting SRBP Update...

j. On 1 May 2025, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was approved by HQMC. Approved MOS: 1371.

k. On 14 May 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and 8 months with an ECC of 13 January 2030.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 12 February 2025, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted to HQMC. At the time of submission, Petitioner was eligible for a Zone B SRB in accordance with references (b) and (c). Petitioner's request was held due to lack of funding. On 14 April 2025, reference (d) was published and did not authorize a Zone B SRB for PMOS1371 effective 15 April 2025. On 1 May 2025, Petitioner's request was approved without SRB. On 14 May 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and 8 months. The Board determined that Petitioner submitted his request prior to the 15 April 2025 deadline in reference (d) and the delay in approval was at no fault of Petitioner, therefore under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 10/11 April 2025 vice 13/14 May 2025 for a term of 4 years and 9 months vice 4 years and 8 months.

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Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone B SRB for PMOS 1371, E6, which is capped at \$17,000. Remaining obligated service to 5 January 2026 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
