1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (the Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show that Petitioner was reimbursed for his Personally Procured Move (PPM) with household goods (HHG).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 31 March 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 6 February 2024, Petitioner entered active duty.

b. On 15 August 2024, Petitioner transferred from ██████████ and reported to ██████████ on 15 August 2024 for duty.

c. On 18 September 2024, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0744), while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of August 2024. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was ██████████ for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 17 August 2024. Petitioner's intermediate (02) activity was ██████████ for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 2 October 2024. Petitioner's intermediate (03) activity was ██████████ for temporary duty under instruction

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with an effective date of arrival of 28 October 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 9 December 2024, with a Projected Rotation Date of December 2028. "This transfer funded for member and AUTH dependents as reflected on service record page two and other supporting documents."

d. On 4 November 2024, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and reported to [REDACTED] on 16 November 2024 for duty.

e. On 1 February 2025, U-Haul issued Petitioner an equipment contract with a total rental charge of \$1,554.50.

f. On 1 February 2025, Certified Automated Truck Scale issued Petitioner a weighmaster certificate at [REDACTED] with a Steer Axle of 3,280 lbs., Drive Axle of 4,700 lbs., Trailer Axle of 00 lbs., and Gross weight of 7,980 lbs.

g. On 2 February 2025, Certified Automated Truck Scale issued Petitioner a weighmaster certificate at [REDACTED] with a Steer Axle of 3,980 lbs., Drive Axle of 7,230 lbs., Trailer Axle of 00 lbs., and Gross weight of 11,300 lbs.

h. On 10 February 2025, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0415), while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of February 2025. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 21 February 2025, with a Projected Rotation Date of December 2028.

i. On 25 February 2025, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and reported to [REDACTED] on 26 February 2025 for duty.

j. On 28 July 2025, NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Norfolk notified this Board that "The member moved prior to issuance of orders. The letter is below, and the documents are attached.

Paragraph 051302 A of the Joint Travel Regulation states that transportation of HHGs at government expenses prior to the issuance of permanent change of station orders is not authorized. Exception is made when the order issuing authority (Navy Military Personnel Command) or member designated representative provides a written statement that orders are forthcoming and shipment may be prior to the official issuance of orders. A review of the documentation supporting the claim shows that you initiated shipment of your HHGs on 02 Feb 2025 prior to the 10 Feb 2025 issue date of your orders. Since shipment was made prior to the issuance of orders, this office has no legal basis to permit payment of your claim."

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that in accordance with reference (b), if the Service

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member has a dependent on the effective date of the Permanent Change of Station order, then transportation for the dependent is authorized from the dependent's location to the Service member's first Permanent Duty Station. Additionally, HHG shipment may be authorized. On 18 September 2024, Petitioner was issued official modification to orders 0744 with and ultimate activity of [REDACTED] with intermediate activities in [REDACTED]. These orders were funded for member and dependents. On 16 November 2024, Petitioner reported to [REDACTED]. On 1 February 2025, Petitioner initiated his PPM from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]. On 10 February 2025, Petitioner was issued orders 0415 to [REDACTED]. The Board agreed that Petitioner was in the accession pipeline until he arrived to the [REDACTED] and his move was in conjunction with those orders, however he was issued new orders in the same locality just after he initiated his PPM, causing his claim to be denied because it was assumed that he moved in conjunction with orders 0415. Therefore, under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner initiated shipment of his HHG under official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0744) vice BUPERS order: 0415.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
