1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show that Petitioner was transferred to the Retired Reserve Awaiting Pay at Age 60.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 April 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 29 January 2002, Petitioner enlisted in the U. S. Marine Corps Reserve for 8 years with an End of Obligated Service of 28 January 2010.

b. Petitioner was released from active duty with an honorable character of service and was issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 22 April 2002 to 5 April 2016 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, the following was listed: Block 2 (Department, Component and Branch) USMC 11.

c. Petitioner was released from active duty with an honorable character of service and was issued a DD Form 214 for the period of 1 April 2019 to 15 September 2019 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, the following was listed: Block 2 (Department, Component and Branch) USMCR C7.

d. On 14 April 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years with a Reserve ECC of 13 April 2025.

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e. On 1 September 2022, Petitioner was promoted to Master Sergeant/E-8.

f. On 13 April 2025, Petitioner was discharged.

g. Assistant, Head, Inactive Reserve Section, Separation and Retirement Branch issued a Career Retirement Credit Report for the period of 29 January 2002 to 13 April 2025 listing the following: Total Inactive Duty Points: 0469. Total Active Duty Points: 05318. Total Points Credit: 05787. Total Satisfactory Years: 21. Total Qualifying Service: 21-00-00. Furthermore, Petitioner's last satisfactory year was 29 January 2022 to 28 January 2023.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was discharged at the expiration of his reserve contract, with 21 years of qualifying service. In accordance with reference (b), a person is entitled upon application to retired pay if the person has performed at least 20 years of service. The Board determined that although Petitioner did not submit a request to transfer to the Retired Reserve prior to his discharge, he met the minimum requirement of 20 years of satisfactory service for retirement, therefore relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's discharge from the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve effective 13 April 2025, is rescinded.

Petitioner was transferred to the Retired Reserve, without pay, effective 1 April 2025 in the rank of Gunnery Sergeant/E-7.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
