Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show that Official Change Duty Orders (BUPERS Order 2493) were amended to remove the line of accounting in order to process a close proximity move request.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 March 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 14 July 2022, Petitioner certified a Record of Emergency Data (DD Form 93) listing the following spouse and children address: ██████████.

b. Petitioner's Application/Record of Emergency Data (NAVPERS 1070/602) printed on 16 March 2025 listed the following spouse and children address: ██████████.

c. On 3 June 2025, TRUIST issued Petitioner a mortgage account statement mailed to ██████████.

d. On 3 June 2025, Petitioner was issued official cancellation of orders (BUPERS order: 0565).

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e. On 17 June 2025, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 1685) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of June 2025. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of July 2025 with a Projected Rotation Date of July 2028.

f. On 9 July 2025, Section [REDACTED] notified [REDACTED] that "[r]equesting to maintain previous Permanent Duty Station (PDS) Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) due to close proximity move per reference (c) and (d). Please remove the funding for a household goods (HHG) move from the members orders and to request an order modification of the said orders.

The member established a residence prior to the date the member's orders were issued, the member will be commuting daily to the new PDS and the commuting distance is reasonable for this geographic location.

With the removal of the funding for an HHG move, the member realizes they have forfeited the authorization for the government to fund a move. Additionally, the member will forfeit the right to receive BAH based on previous PDS if the member moves residence at their own expense. As indicated in the request, the member acknowledges that any obligated service associated with these orders must still be completed."

g. On 24 July 2025, PERS 451, Distribution Policies and Procedures notified AskMNCC that "[t]he request to modify orders to remove the LOA for the purposes of a close proximity move is returned without action as the request is not IAW NAVADMIN 101/10. The member must have requested/approved for the close proximity and have the orders modified prior to execution of orders (detached). Member detached on 30 JUN 2025 rendering them ineligible for a close proximity request. Be advised N/A 101/10 states there are no waivers for this type of request."

h. On 22 December 2025, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account (MMPA) listed the following (Basic Allowance for Housing): ENTRY-OPEN-DT 251103 06 11 1 CNTRL-CODE O ACTN D4 START 251101 ENTLMT-MM 1,448.85 ENTLMT 2,897.70 ENTLMT-NM 2,897.70 ACCOM 1 ZIP-CODE 80914 RENT 0.00 SHARE-NR 1 RENT-STAT R PRCNTGE .00 PROTECTED-RATE 0.00 CLOST-DEPN.

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i. On 16 March 2026, [REDACTED] notified this Board that "I couldn't find anything for him in PPTAS or DPS."

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner received orders 1685 which included funding for a permanent change of station move and travel. Petitioner did not complete the steps required in reference (b) to retain BAH at the old PDS prior to the execution of orders, however Petitioner's gaining command verified that Petitioner maintained a continuous residence in the vicinity of his previous PDS, did not execute a HHG move, and commutes a reasonable distance from his residence to current PDS. Therefore, the Board determined that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner submitted a close proximity move request and it was approved by cognizant authority, prior to the execution of his orders.

Petitioner was authorized BAH at the with dependents rate for "[REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED]" effective 1 July 2025 to present.

Note: If Petitioner moves from his residence, he will no longer be authorized BAH at the Denver, CO 80293 rate. Furthermore, The Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine amounts due, if any.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
