Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 18 December 2025. In your application, you requested your discharge be changed to “medical retirement due to unrecognized service-connected disabling conditions that were not properly evaluated at the time of separation” and the corresponding change to your separation code. You contend you were separated due to a “physical condition not a disability” without being referred to a medical evaluation board or a physical evaluation board (PEB) but your record, as submitted by you, indicated a PEB found you fit for asthma. In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you were discharged in July 2004, observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse the failure to submit the application in a timely manner and was unwilling to waive the three-year statute of limitations due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
