This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 25 September 2025. In your application, you state that you "did not ask Captain [REDACTED] the commanding officer of the [REDACTED] in Nov 1982 to be [your] Vice Presidential running mate. This is fake news on [your] personal record" and you requested to "[d]elete it and [you] want an apology." Additionally, you request a "complete copy of [your] records not redacted in secrecy." In reviewing your application, the Board, noting your discharge from the Navy on 3 March 1983, observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. Thus, the Board was not willing to waive the three-year statute of limitations since the date of discovery and determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
