1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed Enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), seeking to have a detachment of individual evaluation, covering the period of 16 November 2024 to 20 April 2025, removed from his Official Military Personnel File (OMPF).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error or injustice on 20 May 2025. The Board, pursuant to its regulations and on the basis of the available evidence of record, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken with respect to Petitioner's request. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of Petitioner's application, all materials submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under law and regulations applicable to the Department of the Navy.

b. A review of reference (b) reveals that on 8 May 2024, Petitioner was assigned to Naval Special Warfare Command (NSWC) with no detachment date listed. See enclosure (2).

c. In April 2025, Petitioner was issued a detachment of individual evaluation covering the period of 16 November 2024 to 20 April 2025, and showing he was assigned to [REDACTED]. See enclosure (3).

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d. In November 2025, Petitioner was issued a periodic evaluation covering the period of 16 November 2024 to 15 November 2025, which overlapped coverage with the evaluation referenced in paragraph 3c, and indicated he was still assigned to [REDACTED]. See enclosure (4).

e. Petitioner contends enclosure (3) should be removed from his record because he did not detach from [REDACTED] in April 2025 as the evaluation indicates, and it overlaps with enclosure (4), his periodic evaluation. In support of his application, he provided a memorandum from Commander, [REDACTED], certifying that Petitioner was, as of the date of the memorandum, on active duty and attached to [REDACTED], and that he had been attached to [REDACTED], since 8 May 2024. See enclosures (1) and (5).

CONCLUSION:

In its review of the entirety of Petitioner's application file as described above, the Board determined there was an error in Petitioner's record warranting relief. Specifically, the Board was convinced by the evidence provided by Petitioner, namely enclosure (5), that the detachment of individual evaluation contained in enclosure (3) was erroneously issued, because Petitioner was not detached from [REDACTED] in April 2025. The Board additionally noted the overlap in dates covered by the two evaluations. The Board thus concluded Petitioner was not detached from [REDACTED] in April 2025, and that enclosure (3), which overlaps with enclosure (4), was issued erroneously, and should be removed from Petitioner's OMPF.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the above, the Board recommends the following corrective action:

Correct Petitioner's record by removing enclosure (3), the detachment of individual evaluation, covering the period of 16 November 2024 to 20 April 2025.

That no further changes be made to Petitioner's naval record.
