1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 25 July 2024 for a term of 4 years vice 3 years and that he was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 May 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

- a. On 11 September 2018, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. In May 2019, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) C26A. In July 2019, Petitioner was awarded NEC 728A.
- c. On 24 August 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 23 August 2025 and received a Zone A SRB.
- d. On 9 September 2022, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System/Electronic

Service Record shows a 2-month agreement to extend enlistment with a Soft EAOS of 23 October 2025.

e. On 11 September 2024, Petitioner entered Zone B.

f. On 2 April 2025, Petitioner signed a Command Career Request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 3 year reenlistment effective 25 July 2025 and Zone A SRB. Petitioner's request was approved on 9 June 2025 by cognizant authority.

g. On 25 July 2025, [REDACTED] issued Petitioner an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) listing the following: Entitled to SRB based on the CTM Rating/NEC 0000. SRB Zone B. Award Level 4 The total SRB entitlement is \$44,086.60. First installment of \$22,443.30 will be deposited to your DDS account by EFT payment when the entitlement has posted to the Master Pay Account.

h. On 25 July 2025, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years with an EAOS of 24 July 2028.

i. On 28 August 2025, [REDACTED] USN notified this Board that "[d]ue to the erroneous submission of member's reenlistment, member's reenlistment contract is short by one year to carry the member's new End of Active Obligated Service date into Zone C for Selective Reenlistment Bonus. I, as the Command Career Counselor, overlooked the member's extension by two months.

Due to no fault by the member, please allow the member's reenlistment contract to reflect four (4) years of reenlistment vice three (3)."

j. On 29 September 2025, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]), with required obligated service to August 2028, while stationed in [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of January 2026. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 7 February 2026 with a Projected Rotation Date of June 2026.

k. On 30 April 2026, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]), with required obligated service to August 2029, while stationed in [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of July 2026. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 15 August 2026 with a projected rotation date of August 2029.

l. On 11 September 2028, Petitioner will enter Zone C.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board determined that on 2 April 2025 Petitioner signed NPPSC 1160/1 requesting a 3 year reenlistment effective 25 July 2025 and Zone A SRB. On 25 July 2025,

Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years. At that time a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however in accordance with reference (b), when reenlisting for SRB, the reenlistment must take the member's new EAOS into the next SRB zone. The Board determined that Petitioner should have been advised to reenlist for 4 years and Petitioner would have been eligible to receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 25 July 2025 was for a term of 4 years, vice 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone B SRB with an award level of 4.0 (\$75,000 award ceiling) for the CTM rate. Remaining obligated service to 23 August 2025 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
