Dear Petitioner,

This is in reference to your Application for Correction of Military Records, DD Form 149, dated 1 November 2025. In your application, you requested the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) grant promotion to E-8, constructive credit to retire in the grade E-8, correct your DD 214, and backpay.

Our records show that the Board previously considered and denied this request under Docket No. 7849-20, 999-22, and 9259-23. When a request for corrective action is denied by the Board, sitting in executive session, new and material evidence or other matters not previously considered must be submitted to have the Board reconsider its decision. After a careful review of your application and attachments, the Board is unable to find sufficient new evidence, other matters not previously considered by the Board, or material not available when you submitted your previous applications.

In view of the foregoing, there is no action for the Board to adjudicate at this time. Accordingly, your case has been administratively closed. Additionally, in the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the previous Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
