Dear Petitioner:

Reference is made to the Application for Correction of Military Record (DD Form 149) received 13 November 2025.

As explained in the decision document, Docket No. 533-25, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) does not make determinations as to fitness for service as contemplated within the service Disability Evaluation System. As such, the VA benefits letter you submitted in your current application is not material evidence.

When a request for corrective action is denied by the Board, new and material evidence or other matters not previously considered must be submitted to have the Board reconsider its decision. After a careful review of your application, the Board is unable to find sufficient new evidence, other matters not previously considered by the Board, or material not available when you submitted your previous applications.

As such, in the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the previous decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction. Accordingly, your case has been administratively closed.
