Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 19 February 2026. In your application, you requested to have your Physical Evaluation Board (PEB) findings changed to reflect an updated diagnosis, adjust your rating from 60% to 100%, and to receive retroactive benefits. You also requested an administrative correction to your Certificate of Discharge or Release from Active Duty (DD Form 214) to include all of your service, which you assert currently only covers a portion of your service. In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you discharged in 2020, observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse the failure to submit your application in a timely manner and was unwilling to waive the three-year statute of limitations due to the length of time since your discharge.

With respect to your request for an administrative correction to your DD Form 214, the Board recommended that you first seek assistance from Commander, Navy Personnel Command (PERS-313), Records Management Policy Branch, 5720 Integrity Drive, Millington, TN 38055-3130. You may also seek assistance by emailing askmnc@navy.mil.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
