Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 12 March 2026. In your application, you requested correction to your record to reflect retirement in the grade of O-3E rather than E-9 with corresponding changes to your Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) and retired pay, to include back pay and allowances. In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you were retired in 2001 and also discovered the error in 2001, observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse the failure to submit your application in a timely manner and was unwilling to waive the three-year statute of limitations due to the length of time since you retired.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
