Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 9 April 2026. In your application, you requested an upgrade of your discharge—"I have since realized that I was young and dumb. I have been using the military training I received to help my community. I am hopeful that I could [receive] a discharge upgrade to be able to list Veteran on my driver's license and other benefits that come from being a veteran." In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you were discharged in 1993, observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse the failure to submit your application in a timely manner and was unwilling to waive the three-year statute of limitations due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
