1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's End of Active Service date is 13 June 2026 vice 13 June 2027.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████ and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 26 May 2026 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. In accordance with reference (b), Terms of Enlistment... b. Regular Enlistment 1. General. Enlistments [into the Regular Marine Corps for non-prior service or prior service (other service or USKCR K4, K8, K9, or B5) applicants, either directly or from the DEP, will be for terms of 2*, 3, 4, or 5 years). * Note: Two year TOE for NFS enlistments into the National Call to Service Program; actual EAS will be adjusted upon completion of MOS school. 2. Maximum Terms of Enlistment: (a) No "open contract" will be for more than four (4) years.

b. Petitioner's Record of Military Processing – Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 1966) signed on 28 July 2021 listed the following: Block 17 (Dep Enlistment Data) - Block 17k (MSO) 8 years. 17l (AD Obligation) 4 years. Block 18 (Accession Data) – Block 18a (Date of Enlistment) 13 June 2022. Block 18b (Active Duty Service Date) 13 June 2022. Block 34

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(Recertification by Applicant and Correction of Data at the Time of Active Duty Entry) – Block 34c (Change Required) “...4x4 infantry option...”

c. Petitioner’s Enlistment/Reenlistment – Document Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 4) signed on 28 July 2021 listed the following: Block B8 (Agreements) “I am enlisting/reenlisting in the United State MARINE CORPS this date for 8 years 0 months and 0 weeks beginning in pay grade E-1 of which 4 years 0 months and 0 weeks is considered an Active Duty Obligation, and 4 years 0 months and 0 weeks will be served in the Reserve Component of the Service in which I have enlisted.”

d. On 17 May 2022, Petitioner signed Statement of Understanding (Form Number: 1130-UH1) listing the following: Primary Incentive (Job Skill) – Block 4 (Program Code) UH. Block 4a (Program Description) Infantry Option. Block 4b (Military Occupational Field(s)) 0300 – Infantry. Block 5 (I understand I must meet the following criteria, or criteria waiver approved, to qualify for the program listed in Para 4 above) – Block 5b Four (4) Year Term of Enlistment (TOE).

e. On 1 February 2023, Infantry Training Battalion certified that Petitioner “...met all the requirements and you successfully completed the curriculum prescribed by the Commandant of the Marine Corps for the Infantry Marine Corps (0311) given at the School of Infantry (West), Marine Corps Base, [REDACTED].”

f. On 8 March 2023, Commanding Officer issued Petitioner an Administrative Remarks (NAVMC 118(11)) listing the following: “20230308: Counseled this date concerning my dismissal from Reconnaissance Training Company under the drop on request (DOR) policy. I understand that due to my DOR, I have forfeited my chance of receiving the Reconnaissance MOS and any incentive pays associated with being a Reconnaissance Marine.”

g. Marine Corps Total Force System, Basic Individual Record listed the following: End of Active Service (EAS): 12 June 2027. End of Obligated Service (EOS): 27 July 2029. End of Current Contract (ECC): 12 June 2027. Date of Enlistment/Acceptance: 13 June 2022. Armed Forces Active Duty Base Date (AFADB): 13 June 2022. Pay Entry Base Date (PEBD): 13 June 2022. Date of Original Entry: 28 July 2021. Length Current Enlistment: 5 years.

h. On 23 March 2023, Petitioner was assigned Primary Military Occupational Specialties (PMOS) 0311.

i. On 26 May 2026, [REDACTED] Commander, [REDACTED] notified this Board that, “...I am a platoon commander with [REDACTED], currently embarked on the [REDACTED]. I have a Marine who is awaiting BCNR correction for his service record, as it has him erroneously serving an additional year. We received an approval notification from HQMC about correcting the record from his previous 1st Sgt, but we have not received a case number from BCNR via email. As of right now, we are trying to get this Marine home from this deployment, but we cannot do that until a HQMC memo 1070 G-1 form is received by us. The BCNR application was submitted and approved 20260415. The original EAS was 20270612 and corrected to 20260612.”

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CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 13 June 2022, Petitioner entered active duty. His enlistment documents show that his active duty obligation was for four years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 12 June 2026, however the Marine Corps Total Force System lists the length of his current enlistment as 5 years. The Board determined that relief is warranted and Petitioner's EAOS should be 12 June 2026.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's Marine Corps Total Force System, Basic Individual Record listed an ECC of 12 June 2026 vice 12 June 2027.

Petitioner signed a 1 month agreement to extend enlistment with an EAS of 12 July 2026.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
